RE: We will know and understand that Spring is a time when things begin to grow. Lent is a time to grow in love, to be more like Jesus and to look forward to Easter when Jesus rose again.

Personal Social & Emotional Development

We will continue to learn how to resolve conflict and co-operate with each other on completing tasks when working as a team. We will give and receive support when spending time with our friends.

Communication & Language Within a range of situations, we will begin to offer ideas and explanations. We will continue to develop our vocabulary to help us express ourselves using extended language.

Physical development We will continue to spend more time developing the strength and skills in the smallest muscles in our hands. We will become more aware of moving into space and how to avoid obstacles.

Literacy: We will develop our understanding and love of stories practising how to retell them in the correct order, drawing on the language patterns of stories. We will learn to say how we feel about stories and poems, innovating a well-known story. We will say, draw and write stories of our own. We will continue to write our name with only a capital letter at the beginning and lower case for every other letter in our name. We will practise constructing simple sentences and writing phrases using our phonics knowledge to help us.

Maths We will revisit subitising to help us see, solve and manipulate numbers in our heads. This will help us develop our number sense and master key calculation strategies. We will explore and compare length and height and explore time in more detail. We will recognise and name some 2D and 3D shapes.

Expressive Arts

We will explore art from Friedensreich Hundertwasser. We will use his art as an inspiration for designing buildings, creating structure and creativity.

Understanding the world

We will build on our previous learning and understanding that our environment and living things can be influenced by humans.

Phonics

We will continue to learn new sounds as we work through our phonics programme. This term we will look at oo, ar, or, ur and ow and consolidate all previously taught sounds.

French

We will continue to learn French nursery rhymes recognising them from familiar songs that we know in English.
