

PE is on a Monday and Thursday. Please come to school wearing PE kit. Forest School will be on a Tuesday. Please wear your Forest School clothes to school on this day. RE: In our RE learning we will start by celebrating the season of creation. Exploring the story of creation and delving into what God created. We will be looking closely into beginnings and how God is there at every beginning throughout our lives.

Writing and Reading: This term we will be focusing on what makes a sentence and developing our understanding of the different types of sentences including statements, questions and exclamations. We will be using the text 'How to be a Lion' by Ed Vere as a focus to write from. The children are then going to be enjoying a range of poetry and rhymes. We will continue on our phonics and reading journey to really consolidate our reading skills and build on our fluency.

Maths: In Maths, we will be building on our skills and knowledge of last year and really digging deeper into place value within 10 as well as partitioning, recognising tens and ones and continuing to ensure that we are counting carefully and accurately. We will revisit writing numbers in words. Our problem solving and reasoning skills will develop as we are given more open-ended opportunities to explore Maths in different contexts.

Science: This term the children identify animals, plants and microorganisms. We will understand and compare various habitats, such as oceans, deserts and forests. We will explore simple food chains and the role of producers and consumers.

History: Memory Box This term the children will learn more about changes over time, family and community. This topic will develop their knowledge and appreciation of local history, special memories, customs and traditions and we will look deeper into how we have changed and grown over time.

PE:

In our PE learning this term on a Monday we will be doing Tri Golf (outdoors) and on a Thursday we will be doing Gymnastics (indoors.)

Music:

This term the children will learn to play Boomwhackers. We will learn individually then developing a classroom band and finally joining a large ensemble.

RSE/PSHCE:

We will learn how we are created and loved by God out of love and for love. We will learn how to value ourselves as the basis for our relationships.

Art/D&T:

This term we will build on our knowledge and understanding of the colour wheel and colour theory. We will explore primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their own artwork.

French: In our French learning we will be learning words connected to Transport and the jungle as well as revisiting rhymes and greetings from last year.

Computing: We will be developing our understanding of technology and how it can help us. We will become more familiar with the different components of a computer.
